2020 has been a year like no other we have known in our lifetime and as the build-up to Christmas approaches, we wanted to let you know about some important decisions. It is likely that your traditions and celebrations will look different this year and unfortunately, that will be the same in school. We have risk assessed all that we are able to do and will try our best to make the lead up to Christmas as happy and memorable as is possible in the current climate.

As always, our Christmas tree will decorate the main entrance to school from next week as classes across school discuss Advent and the true meaning of Christmas for Christians.

Reverend Jeanette Roberts has generously offered to record a number of services that will be shared with children that can be accessed both in school and at home. Although different to previous years, our KS1 crib service and KS2 advent services will be an opportunity to share the special messages of Christmas. We are also working to plan an opportunity for all pupils to make their own Christingle.

In the final week of term, children will have some Christmas craft afternoons to produce some creative things to bring home for parents to treasure.

These afternoons will replace the usual class parties and we will not be asking for any food contributions from parents this year.

Charity will remain an important part of our Christmas plans and we will be running two events, one of which is our annual Christmas jumper day, in support of Overgate Hospice on the final day of term. More information will follow next week.

Finally, after careful consideration, we have made the decision that we are not able to allow children to exchange Christmas cards in school this year and staff are unable to accept gifts from children. As with much of this year, we know that children will continue to adapt to the situation, inventing creative solutions to wishing their friends and teachers a Merry Christmas! I trust that you understand we do not take these decisions lightly, but always in the best interests of maintaining safety for all in our St. Peter's community during the pandemic.
