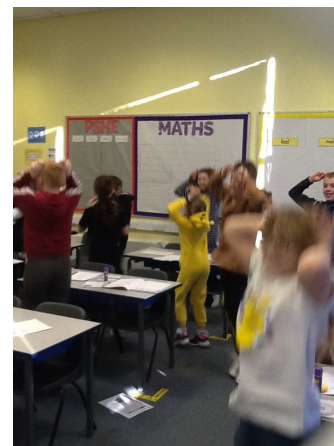
Fun Fundraiser for Children in Need

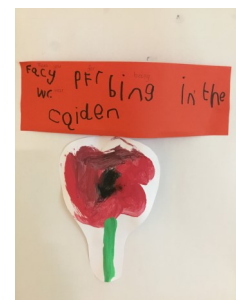
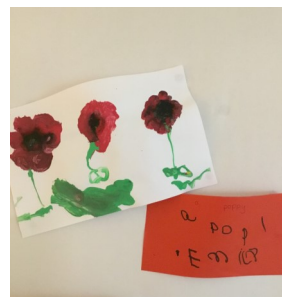
