**Earth** - Macy H. For having an excellent attitude to learning in our first week back at school.

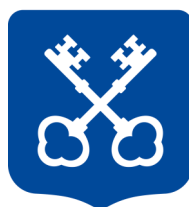
**Mars** - Lola-Rose D. For settling back in so well to the classroom environment and for trying very hard with her writing.

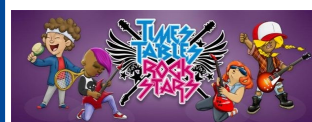

## Wraparound Care



We know some parents will be starting to return to work, which is why we would like to remind you that we offer Breakfast and After School Club in school every day. Breakfast club is £3.50 a session starting at 7:45am where there will be a selection of cereals, bread or toast with a selection of toppings. After school club (Ossh), is on until 5pm. Both clubs need to be paid and booked in advance via the MyChildAtSchool app. Spaces are limited. If you do not book in, unfortunately you will be turned away.

## Behaviour Points
