
#### Sun Cream

#### **NSPC PANTS RULES**

In our PSHE lessons this week, we have been discussing the NSPCC's PANTS rules. These are designed to teach pupils how to stay safe, without giving explicit information or telling scary stories. In the lesson, children have been learning about the 'PANTS' acrostic, which stands for:

- Privates are private.
- Always remember your body belongs to you.
- No means no
- Talk about secrets that upset you
- Speak up, someone can help.

#### COVID-19 Update

Bubbles across Calderdale have been forced to close this week, with some areas of the district running surge testing, following increased cases of the Delta variant. Unfortunately the virus is still prevalent in our communities and we ask that you continue to do all you can to follow the guidance outside of school.

#### Symptoms of COVID 19

- New continuous cough and /or
- High temperature
- A loss of, or change in, normal taste/smell



#### Do not send your child to school if they display any of the three symptoms.

#### How to stop COVID 19 spreading

There are things you can do to help reduce the risk of you and anyone you live with getting ill with COVID 19:

- Wash your hands often for at least 20 seconds.
- Use hand sanitizer if soap is not available.
- Wash your hands as soon as you get home.
- Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue (not hands) when you cough or sneeze
- Put tissues in the bin immediately after using.
