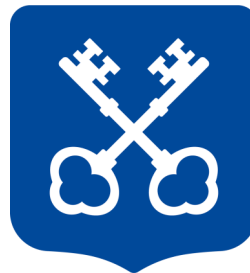

Halloween Safety

All the children are getting super excited about Halloween! You may have seen the safety warnings on various social media platforms this month so I wanted to take the opportunity to share them on our school newsletter:

1. Carry glow sticks or flashlights, use reflective tape or stickers on costumes and bags, and wear light colours to help children see and be seen by drivers.
2. Join children under age 12 for trick-or-treating.
3. Slow down and be alert! Children are excited on Halloween and may dart into the street. Turn on headlights early in the day to spot kids from further away.
4. Remind children to cross the road at crossing points.
5. When selecting a costume, make sure it is the right size to prevent trips and falls. Choose face paint over masks when possible. Masks can limit children's vision.
