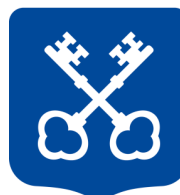
Reception - Hope F— for always leading by example in all aspects of school life. She is a delight to have in the classroom.

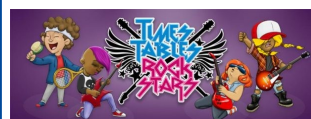
