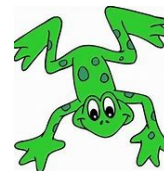
Any donations of cakes and tombola prizes are also greatly appreciated. Please can these be given in to the school office no later than Friday 8 July.

### Clubs - Cancellation Reminder

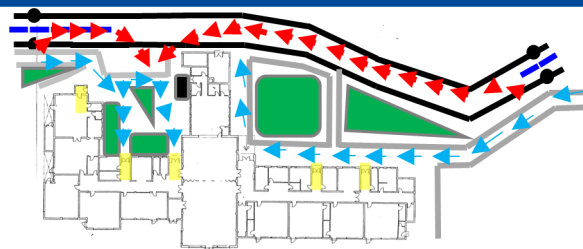
