Dear Parents/Carers,

We are very excited about our residential trip next week! We have sent out the kit list, but I just wanted to share some extra information with you about the trip.

#### Drop off arrangements

On Wednesday, the children will need to come in at 9:00am. This 5-minute stagger will allow the other classes to enter the building before Year 6 arrive with their luggage. The children do not need to arrive in their uniform, they can arrive in appropriate residential clothing (no jeans). Please ensure that all children have a waterproof coat, as detailed in the kit list.

#### Departure

The coach is not due to pick us up until 12:45pm, so we have planned a range of team building and sports activities for the children to get into the spirit of the things and to get even more excited!

#### Snacks

A lot of the children have been asking about the possibility of bringing snacks; snacks are allowed in bags, for the evenings, but they will not be allowed on the coach.

#### Spending money

If you do want to send your child with spending money, there is a small shop on the site which the children will have the opportunity to visit. We ask they do not bring any more than £10. If your child brings more than £10, they will only be allowed to spend £10. If your child does want an adult to look after this, it needs to be in a sealed, named envelope.

#### Medication

Any medication should be clearly labelled and handed to Miss Eccles who will oversee the administration of this. Please note that you will have to complete a medical form prior to the children leaving. If you would like to complete this before Wednesday, then please contact the school office.

#### Electronic devices

Please do not allow your children to bring any electronic devices. We will take lots of photographs and share these with you on our return. Children can bring a book to read or a colouring book and pencils if they wish (no felt tips please).

#### Collection

Children will need to be picked up at the usual time on Friday (3:20pm). I sure that they will be full of stories and memories to share with you but will be ready for their beds!
