Reading Challenge

Here at TASP, we love reading and believe that reading is the most important skill children can learn. With that in mind, we want to reward children who read regularly.

Children will receive one point for every day they read at home and parents/carers record in their planner that they have read. This will be checked by staff in school who will keep a record in their planner.

When children reach 20 points, they will receive a Bronze certificate and a bookmark.

When they reach 50 points, they receive a Silver certificate, 10 Achievement Points (APs) and a pass for a library story time session with a Senior Leader (complete with hot chocolate and biscuit!).

When they reach 75 points, they will receive 15 APs.

When they reach 100 points, they receive a Gold certificate, 20 APs and school will buy them a book of their choice.
