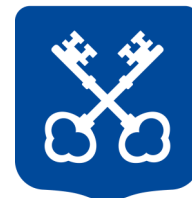

Bikeability - Summer Holiday Courses

We're pleased to be able to offer a range of Bikeability courses at TASP over the Summer holidays!

Bikeability aim to help your child with a range of skills on a bike. They start from balance bikes, and move through those children who are able to ride and want to learn new skills, to progressing to an introduction to the road. **Any pupils on Free School Meals will be able to have the course cost refunded if they attend.** Please see below the courses that will be on offer.

Learn to Ride courses: A one day course starting on balance bikes and moving onto pedal bikes through a series of games and exercises. Suitable for children aged 5-9yrs. Bikes and helmets supplied. They will need a packed lunch and outdoor clothing for the day. There are a maximum of 18 child places per course @£11.55 per child. Booking is via Eventbrite and courses will be run on **Monday 7 & Tuesday 8 August from 10am-3pm.**
