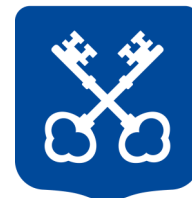

They worked in the woodwork department and made themselves a sweet dispenser that they have brought home. Both Jack and JJ said they had so much fun!

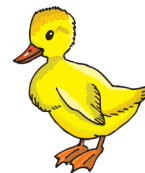

TASP Forest School

We are excited to welcome Ms. Gravestock to TASP to offer our children a Forest School experience.



She will be here with us for 2 afternoons a week in Year 1/2 and Year 3/4. Throughout the sessions your children will be exploring topics such as sustainable development, local bio-diversity and environmental interaction. They aim to encourage pupils to explore their natural, local space and geography.

Ms. Gravestock will also be running after school clubs for our Year 5 and Year 6 students.

On **Tuesdays** she will run a Gardening Club which will focus on a range of activities and games based around planting & growing.

On **Thursdays** she will then run an Eco Club. This is open to the Earthshot Eco-Committee in Y5/6 and any other Y5/6 children that are interested in helping and contributing towards the project. This will focus more on environmental activities.

For these clubs, a letter has been sent out today to gain interest/permission. Both clubs will start after school next week from **3:20pm to 4:20pm**. REMINDER - School Disco

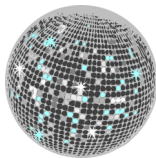
The dates for the school disco are fast approaching so, if you haven't already, please sign your child up if they would like to attend via the link below.
