Children should also ensure that they are bringing full water bottles to school everyday in the warmer weather.



REMINDER - Bicycles/Scooters on the school grounds

Please ensure that, if your child rides a bike or scooter to school, that they are either using the road to ride to the bike storage shed or are getting off and pushing this through the school grounds.

We have found that some children are riding in the pedestrian areas at fast speeds, which poses a danger to themselves and other adults/children.

We would also recommend that your child wears a safety helmet to school when riding if possible.
