



As a reminder, children will need to come to school wearing the clothes that they intend to take part in. These must be clothes that you do not mind getting dirty. You will then need to send a complete set of dry clothes (including clean shoes and underwear!) for your child to change in to for the journey home, an old towel to clean up with and 2 black bin liners to store muddy/wet clothes and to use as a seat cover on the coach.

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
