#### **Magna Science Trip**


On Wednesday, Moore class ventured to Sheffield for their class trip to Magna Science Adventure Centre.

On Tuesday, after being cancelled previously due to the bad weather, some of our KS2 children were finally able to take part in the Outdoor Athletics event at Ryburn.






They competed in a multitude of events, such as running races, long jump and throwing, against children in the same age group from lots of other primary schools.

Thank you to the parents/carers who were able to join us for the assembly. We also would like to thank Mr. Rhodes for his wonderful music tuition throughout the year.






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
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#### Other news and reminders this week
