Ms. Gravestock has hit the ground running with getting the children back in to forest school and a multitude of other eco activities.

The first week she started off with our eco-committee, who conducted a habitat audit around our school grounds. She then worked with Year 3/4, creating cave paintings outside.

Finally, she worked with Year 5 who are taking part in the wild challenge which is run by the RSPB. There are 2 parts to this challenge which are to 'Help nature' and 'Experience nature'. The children collected several natural items from around the school grounds so that they experience different aspects of nature through their surroundings.

Ultimately the aim is to use the results of the habitat audit to help nature through the creation of a TASP rock pile and other things in the upcoming weeks. This will serve as a habitat for all of the insects that live in our school grounds. Watch this space for further updates!


