Mr. Shepherd and Mrs. Taylor are so proud of everyone who has taken part. Well done!

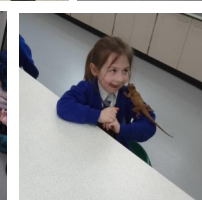


#### Year 1/2 go 'Into the Wild'!

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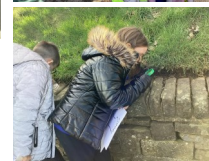
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## Other news and reminders this week
