ACE - New Wraparound Care Provision

From **Monday 20 May**, our After School Club provision will be changing until the Summer.

Going forward, if you need to book your child into wraparound care after school, then you will need to book on to ACE club via the MCAS app or the school office. This will be available from **3:30pm to 5pm** every day, and will cost **£2 per day**. We will be offering a different activity each day, please see the below schedule:

- ◆ Monday - Football & Multi Sports
- ◆ Tuesday - Dodgeball & Multi Sports
- ◆ Wednesday - Gymnastics & Multi Sports
- ◆ Thursday - Tag Rugby & Multi Sports
- ◆ Friday - Dance & Multi Sports



As well as being a provision available to our parents/carers who require childcare, the club will be available to the whole school to book on to as and when needed, or even if your child would just like to attend that particular activity.

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REMINDER: Attendance

If attendance drops below 95% then children are at risk of falling into the category of persistent absence. Attendance is discussed at termly attendance reviews with the Educational Welfare Service and letters are sent out periodically to make you aware of your child's attendance figure, and to advise of ways to improve this.



REMINDER: Borrowing Uniform

We have recently lent out a large amount of school uniform items that children are not subsequently returning to school.

Miss Tetley conducts a uniform check each day, and then collects this in before the children go home. However, sometimes this is not always possible, for example if a child has ripped an item of clothing, and we have to send them home wearing our spare school clothes.

Please can you ensure that if you have any items at home that have been loaned out, that you return them to school ASAP in a suitable, clean condition. This includes uniforms, PE kits and shoes. We need to ensure that the spare uniform is available to all children at school should it be needed.

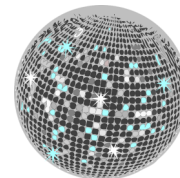
